Luncheon Speaker -- **Dorothy Espelage**

### ***Preventing Bullying and Sexual Harassment Among Adolescents: Two Decades of Research to Inform the #MeToo Movement***



Dr. Espelage is Professor of Psychology at UF. She is the recipient of the Lifetime Achievement Award in Prevention Science and the 2016 Award for Distinguished Contributions to Research in Public Policy, both from the American Psychological Association. She earned her Ph.D. in Counseling Psychology from Indiana University. Dr. Espelage has authored over 140 peer reviewed articles, five edited books, and 30 chapters on bullying, homophobic teasing, sexual harassment, dating violence, and gang violence. Her well-funded research centers on translating empirical findings into prevention and intervention programming. She has advised members of

Congress on bullying prevention legislation and has appeared on television news shows and is quoted in the national press.
