

Stan Kaye, a theater lighting designer with over 40 years of experience, presented a lecture titled "A Journey on Ways of Light: Theater, Museums, and the Art of Consultation." He shared a mosaic of his work through images, emphasizing the importance of audience engagement and the role of lighting in enhancing theatrical experiences. Kaye highlighted the evolution of lighting design from natural light to electric lighting and discussed the influence of Dutch masters like Rembrandt and Vermeer on contemporary lighting techniques. He also touched on his interdisciplinary work with the School of Architecture at UF and the profound impact of lighting on theatrical staging.
