Katie Meleccio, the Dean of the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences at UF, discussed the University's AI initiatives and her background in engineering and agriculture. She presented UF's strategic initiative to become a leader in AI, highlighting the university's partnerships, curriculum development, and the heavy use of AI tools by students. The presentation covered five main themes of AI implementation at UF, including education, research, operations, student support, and governance, while demonstrating a new Navigator AI Tutor tool and addressing concerns about AI ethics and decision-making. 
